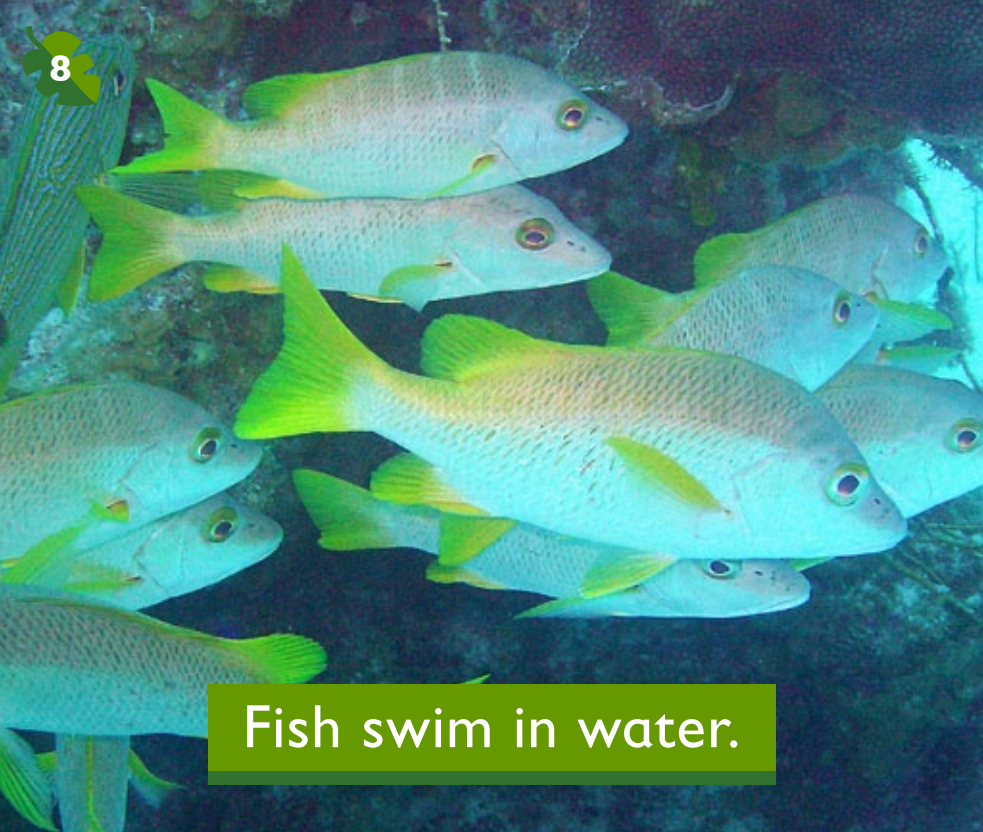
An orangutan drinks water.
